

1 Monday - August 12th. 1912.

2 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal
 3 Hall on Monday - August 12th. 1912 at 8 o'clock, p.m.

4 Present:- Acting Reeve Mr. Gregor.

5 Councillors MacDonald, Faure, Britton, Mayne and Madill.

6 Moved by Cr. Britton - Seconded by Cr. Mac Donald: - "That the Minutes
 7 of the Meetings of August 5th. and July 29th. be adopted as
 8 typewritten, and confirmed".

9 Carried unanimously.

10 B. G. Walker Esq., R. L. Hodgson Esq and John Armstrong Esq
 11 attended as a Deputation from the Joint Harbour Committee, and
 12 addressed the Council with reference to obtaining a Grant for
 13 the purpose of securing an Enactment by the Dominion Parliament
 14 creating a Board of Harbour Commissioners for the North Arm
 15 of the Fraser River.

16 Moved by Cr. Faure. Seconded by Cr. Britton: - "That this Council,
 17 having heard the report of the Joint Committee of Councils and
 18 Boards of Trade of South Vancouver, Burnaby, New and
 19 Point Grey, appointed to consider the question of the creation of
 20 a Harbour on the North Arm of the Fraser River, hereby expresses
 21 its approval of the recommendation now submitted by such
 22 joint Committee, and in accordance therewith will apply, in
 23 conjunction with other interested Councils for the passage of a
 24 Bill by the Federal Government constituting a Board of Harbour
 25 Commissioners, to have jurisdiction over the whole of the
 26 North Arm of the Fraser River from the western boundary of
 27 the City of New Westminster to the City of Georgia. And
 28 further, this Council votes the sum of \$350 with further
 29 advances if necessary, but the whole not to exceed \$500.
 30 towards the expenses of obtaining such enactment".

31 Carried unanimously.

32 Moved by Cr. Britton - Seconded by Cr. Mayne: - "That the Reeve be
 33 appointed as the representative of this Council on the Joint Harbour
 34 Committee, and that during his absence, the Acting Reeve be
 35 the representative.

36 Carried unanimously.

37 Committee Reports.

38 Board of Works: - Your Committee met on July 29th. and
 39 recommended:-

- 40 1. That Sprott Road be cleared 16 feet wide and planed, at
 41 an estimated cost of \$500.
- 42 2. That Pole Line Road, north of Burnaby Lake tram-line, be re-planed
 43 and that the appropriation from the 1912 By-Law for planing
 44 Piper Rd. be utilised for this work, in addition to the balance

from the 1911 By Law appropriation.

Board of Works: - Your Committee met on August 5th. and recommend:-

1. That the Solicitors be instructed to proceed with the drafting of the Agreement re. B.C.E.Ry. "Cut-off".
2. That permission be granted to G.H. Webster to temporarily use the Royal Oak Rd. for the purpose of unloading material from the B.C.E.Ry. for Mto. 2 Reservoir, subject to an Agreement to be drawn up by the Solicitors.
3. That the time for the construction of the Gear to the rock-crushing plant be extended to date from the time formal permission is given by the Council to the B.C.E.Ry. to use the Streets for this purpose.
4. That the Rock crusher be removed from North Burnaby to the corner of Pole Line Rd. and Kenneth Rd.
5. That the B.C.E.Ry. Co. be requested to place Danger Lights on any cars left standing on the Edmonds Street switch over the night.

Moved by Mr. MacDonald. Seconded by Mr. Fauvel: - "That the Reports of the Board of Works of July 29th and August 5th. be adopted".

Carried unanimously.

Finance Committee Report: - Your Committee met on July 29th. and recommend:-

1. That Salaries, amounting to \$2899.40, be paid.
2. That General Accounts, amounting to \$584.42, be paid.
3. That Contract Accounts, amounting to \$1150.00, be paid.
4. That Pay Rolls, amounting to \$20660.45, be paid.
5. That the letter from Mr. J.A. Roden, Provincial Superintendent of the Ocean Accident & Guarantee Corporation, Ltd. be accepted as an interim guarantee in respect of Contract No. 14. - Messrs. Macpherson and Amritage.
6. That the account of Messrs. Lewis & Smellie for \$65, be paid.
7. That Mr. C. MacDonald, be granted an Honorarium of \$100.

Moved by Cr. Britton. Seconded by Cr. Mayne: - "That the Report of the Finance Committee be adopted".

Carried unanimously.

Water Committee Report: - Your Committee met on August 5th., and recommend:-

1. That the Waterworks Engineers be instructed to instal the 60000 gallon Tank at Edmonds, at an approximate cost of \$1450, provided sufficient funds are available.

Moved by Cr. Macdill. Seconded by Cr. Fauvel: - "That the Report of the Water Committee be adopted".

Carried unanimously.

1 Plan Report - Tentative.

2 114. Re-subdivision of Lots 12, 13, 32 and 33 of the southerly
 3 portion of D. L. 94.

4 Recommend for approval as submitted.

5 115. Blocks 10 and 11 - southerly portion of D. L. 11.

6 Recommend for approval as submitted.

7 119. Blocks 3 and 4, N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ and N. E. portion of S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$, D. L. 145.

8 In order to overcome the difficulty of obtaining an outlet to
 9 the River Rd., the owners offer to grant a 33' road
 10 allowance off the south of their property, as shown in red
 11 on plan. While this arrangement would provide for the
 12 required outlet, it would create a hardship on the
 13 owner of the small area of land lying between this
 14 subdivision and River Rd., who, when subdividing, will
 15 require to give an additional 33' road allowance, in
 16 addition to giving a 66' road allowance on the west
 17 side and a 33' road allowance on the east side,
 18 comprising about one third of the entire three acre
 19 portion. Before finally approving this sub-division, I
 20 would recommend that arrangements be made for the
 21 granting or expropriating of the 66' road on the west of
 22 M^r. Bond's property. I may say that I have already
 23 written M^r. Bond, the owner of the three acre portion,
 24 and would advise that the sub-division be held over
 25 until hearing from him.

26 Moved by Cr. Madill - Seconded by Cr. Mac. Donald: - "That the
 27 Plan Report be adopted".

28 Carried unanimously.

29 The Engineer recommended that permission be granted to
 30 the B. C. R. Ry. Co. for the construction of the proposed Spur
 31 line to the Rock lumber site in D. L. 145, provided it is
 32 constructed on the north side of the road, about six feet from
 33 the centre line of the road reservation to the centre line of
 34 the track.

35 Moved by Cr. Fan Vel - Seconded by Cr. Britton: - "That the recommendation
 36 of the Engineer be adopted, and permission granted accordingly."

37 Carried unanimously.

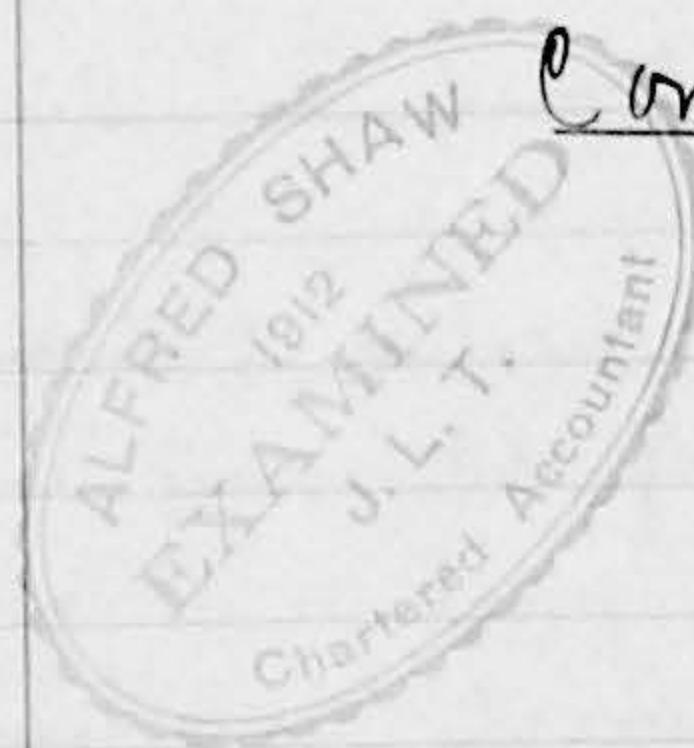
38 The Committee re. Pole Location - W. C. P. Co. recommended that a
 39 location be granted to the Western Canada Power Co. for a High
 40 Tension Pole Line, along the north side of Douglas Rd. to Boundary
 41 Road.

42 Moved by Cr. Fan Vel - Seconded by Cr. Britton: - "That the
 43 recommendation of the committee be adopted".

44 Carried unanimously.

45 Moved by Cr. McGregor - Seconded by Cr. Madill: - "That leave of absence

1 for 3 or 4 weeks, be granted to Mr. Britton."
2 carried unanimously.
