2 An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal

8 Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Mr. Gregor:- "That the
9 Minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as typewritten, and
10 confirmed.

11 A Letter, together with a copy of suggested Amendments to the
12 Municipal Clauses Act, was received from the Point Grey
13 Council.

14 Moved by Cr. Madill, Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That the ^{abt.} suggested
15 " That this Council is of the opinion that the Municipal Clauses Act should
16 be so amended as to give to Municipalities, power to instal, maintain
17 and operate Transportation as set forth in the Amendments proposed
18 by the Municipality of Point Grey, and that this Council do endorse
19 the proposed Amendments or such other Amendments as in the
20 opinion of the Crown would be advantageous to the Municipalities,
21 and further, that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Hon.
22 the Premier."

Donald:- "That the Clerk prepare and forward to Wood Gundy & Co., a sealed copy of the respective By Laws, as now finally passed; and that Wood Gundy and Co. be and are hereby authorised to negotiate the Sale of the Debentures, fixing time and amount, and further, that the Clerk prepare everything necessary for the printing of the Debenture Bonds".
