

Monday - July 29th. 1912.

A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, July 29th. 1912 at 8 O'clock. p.m.

Present:- Acting Reeve Mc.regor.

Councillors Fauvel, Britton and Mayne.

Moved by Cr. Britton - Seconded by Cr. Fauvel:- "That the Minutes of the Meeting of July 15th. inst. be adopted as typewritten, and confirmed."

Carried unanimously.

A Deputation from East Burnaby attended and protested against the proposed Siding on Fourth Avenue.

No action was taken until the reading of the Board of Works reports.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

C. M. C. North Vancouver, asking that the Council would purchase \$50,000 worth of Stock in the Burrard Inlet Bridge & Tunnel Company.

Moved by Cr. Fauvel, Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That this matter be deferred until the return of the Reeve."

Carried unanimously.

The G. V. Ry. Co. forwarded Blue Print of the proposed double tracking from Sapperton to Still Creek.

Moved by Cr. Britton - Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That this matter be referred to the Board of Works."

Carried unanimously.

Solicitors - enclosing partial release of Mortgage - Mark Marsh to Burnaby.

Moved by Cr. Britton - Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That the release be signed by the Acting Reeve and Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

"E". also the road through the centre of the Block to be set in alignment with 4th Avenue in D. L. 55 - Recommend for approval subject to corrections shown in red on the plan.

1 115- Block 11. D.L. 154.

2 Recommend for approval subject to the grant of a 10' Lane  
3 allowance along the north side of Blk. 11. and 20' Lane  
4 allowance in place of the 14' Lane in the southerly portion  
5 of the block, as shown in red on the plan.


