

1 Monday February 5th. 1912.

2 An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal
3 Hall on Monday, February 5th. 1912, at 8 O'clock p.m.

4 Present:- His Worship Reeve Weast

5 Councillors, Mc Gregor, Mac Donald, Britton, Madill and Mayne.

6 Mr Goodlad attended and addressed the Council in support of a
7 Petition for opening Streets in S. L. G.O.

8 Moved by Cr. Britton, Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That the Petition be
9 referred to the Engineers to report."

10 Carried unanimously.

11 Mr Cummings addressed the Council with reference to the surface
12 water on Roberts Road.

13 Moved by Cr. Britton - Seconded by Cr. Madill:- "That Mr
14 Cummings state the facts of his complaint in writing, and that
15 when it is received, the Engineers submit a report thereon".

16 Carried unanimously.

17 Mr Jesse Love addressed the Council on the matter of an open well
18 at Buena Vista which was so near the road as to be dangerous
19 and also on the matter of open water main trenches in East
20 Burnaby.

21 Moved by Cr. Britton - Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That the owners
22 of the well at Buena Vista be required to take immediate steps
23 to fill it and protect the public, and that Messrs. Cleveland
24 and Cameron be asked to expedite the laying of the water main
25 in this district".

26 Carried unanimously.

27 The Clerk reported that an Order of the Court had been received
28 instructing Councillor Mc Kee for Ward IV, and ordering a fresh
29 election to take place on February 14th. 1912, and the Nomination
30 day therefor, on February 12th. 1912.

31 Moved by Cr. Mc Gregor - Seconded by Cr. Britton:- "That the place of
32 nomination be at the Municipal Hall"

33 Carried unanimously.

34 Moved by Cr. Mc Gregor, Seconded by Cr. Britton:- "That the Municipal
35 Clerk be appointed as Returning Officer, and that he be empowered
36 to appoint the Deputy Returning Officers."

38 Moved by Cr. Mac Donald - Seconded by Cr. Madill:- "That the
39 Polling places be the same as were used at the Municipal Election
40 on January 13th. 1912."
