3 A Special Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal  
4 Hall etc on Monday, November 10th. 1913, at 12-30 noon.

Present: His worship Reeve Mc. Gregor.

6 Councillors Van Vel, MacDonald, Macpherson, Coldicutt, Mayne,  
7 and Stride.

The Finance Committee recommended "That this Council accept  
89% nett in London, England, for \$1,250,000, three year 6% Treasury  
Certificates received by the unsold Debentures of this Corporation,  
amounting to \$1416.000, payable as follows:

12        \$250,000 so soon as the Debentures under which the  
13        Treasury Certificates are authorised, are deposited in trust.  
14        The balance to be under option for 60 days, from date, at  
15        the same price.

16 That John A. Mac Donald be appointed the Fiscal Agent of this  
17 Corporation during the life of the Treasury Certificates, provided  
18 the whole Issue of \$1250000 is sold by the said John A.  
19 Mac Donald, and further provided that the time and place of  
20 the sale of the Debentures be always at the discretion of this  
21 Corporation; and that the said John A. Mac Donald makes an  
22 Issue of the whole of the Treasury Certificates, amounting to  
23 \$1250000 within the said period of 60 days.

24 further, that these arrangements be confirmed by an Agreement  
25 to be executed by the respective parties hereto.

26 Moved by Mr. Van Vel. Seconded by Mr. Goldicutt :—"That the  
27 recommendation of the Finance Committee be adopted".

33 the Solicitor, Engineer & Clerk be a delegation to attend this  
34 hearing, and at the same time to obtain the assent of the Lieut.  
35 Governor to the Treasury Certificate By Law. 1913., and that the  
36 expenses of the delegation be paid when funds are available.

 2 and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto.

Carried unanimously.

4 Moved by Cr. Fan Vel, Seconded by Cr. Mac. Donald: - "That this  
 5 Council will accept the same acreage in Blocks 54 and 55, D.L.31,  
 6 as is contained in First Street, Dock St. and Quay St. which  
 7 will be closed by the proposed cancellation, subject to the  
 8 report of the Engineer as to the physical features."

Carried unanimously.

10 Messrs. Davis, Marshall, Mr. Weill & Hugh wrote, asking for a list of  
 11 claims filed against the Canadian Mineral Rubber Co. with  
 12 respect to the Knipsway contract.

13 Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Boldicutt: - "That the  
 14 letter be referred to the Corporation Solicitor."

Carried unanimously.
