2 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal
 3 Hall on Monday, August 11th. 1913, at 8.15 O'clock, p.m.

4 Present:- His worship Reeve Mr. Pegor.

5 Councillors Fau Vel, Mac Donald, Macpherson, Coldicutt, Mayne, and
 6 Stride.

7 Moved by Cr. Mac Donald. Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the Minutes
 8 of the Meeting of July 28th. ult. be adopted as typewritten, and
 9 confirmed."

10 Carried unanimously.

His worship the Reeve explained the financial situation, and also the offer of Messrs. Boulton Bros. of London, England, whereby Burnaby should hypothecate with them the whole of the unsold Debentures, receiving in return 9½% nett at 6% per. annum for 10 years, with the option of redemption of the loan in whole or part, at any time after two years, and all conditional upon the conversion of the 4½% Debentures to 5% Debentures.

There was no Resolution herein.


M. Wright of Alta Vista, addressed the Council re. Fares on Central Park Line, B.C.E.Ry.
