

Monday. October 13th. 1913.

3 An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the
4 Municipal Hall on Monday, October 13th. 1913. at 9.30 p.m.

5 Present:- His worship Reeve W. Gregor.

6 Councillors Mac Donald, Macpherson, Fauvel, Coldicutt, Mayne
7 and Stride.

8 Moved by Cr. Coldicutt. Seconded by Cr. Fauvel:- "That this
9 Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole to
10 reconsider the Burnaby Debenture Further Hypothecation
11 By Law 1913".

12 Carried unanimously

13 The Committee, on rising, reported the By Law complete.

14 Moved by Cr. Fauvel, Seconded by Cr. Stride:- "That the
15 Burnaby Debenture Further Hypothecation By Law 1913, be read a
16 Third time."

17 Carried

18 Cr. Macpherson objecting.

19 Moved by Cr. Fauvel, Seconded by Cr. Coldicutt:- "That the
20 Burnaby Debenture Further Hypothecation By Law 1913, do pass
21 the Third Reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk,
22 and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

23 Carried

24 Cr. Macpherson objecting.

25 Moved by Cr. Coldicutt - Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That the
26 Waterworks Regulation By Law 1912, Amendment By Law 1913, be laid
27 over for one week, and a copy be sent to each Councillor."

28 Carried unanimously.

29 Moved by Cr. Coldicutt - Seconded by Cr. Mac Donald:- "That the
30 Quit Claim, Burnaby to the City of Vancouver, of Burnaby's
31 interest in Seymour Creek Watershed lands, be signed by the
32 Reeve and Clerk and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

33 Carried unanimously.

34 Cr. Macpherson asked the Sewerage Commissioner the following
35 questions:-

- 36 1. Why has the Commission not reported before as to meetings
37 of which we have information only through the Press?
- 38 2. What final averages have been made by the Sewerage
39 Commission, what work has been already commenced, and
40 what is contemplated for the near future?
- 41 3. What effect it will have on Burnaby, and what portion
42 will Burnaby have to pay for?
- 43 4. What will be the approximate estimate for Burnaby for the
44 ensuing year, for the Greater Vancouver Sewerage Commission?
- 45 5. What will the Sewerage Commission define as being general

1 expenses, of which all the interested Municipalities will pay an
 2 equal proportion, and what will be the proportion for Burnaby?
 3 He suggested that a copy of all Minutes of the Sewerage Commission
 4 be forwarded to this Council, so that they might be discussed,
 5 and matters concerning Burnaby, be gone fully into.

6 Cr. MacDonald replied.

7 Cr. Macpherson verbally tendered his resignation as Chairman of
 8 the Sewerage & Transportation Committee, and was asked to put
 9 the same in writing.


10 Moved by Cr. MacDonald - Seconded by Cr. Stride:- "That the
 11 Water Superintendent bring in a report re. verbal applications
 12 for water supply to Burgess St. and Campbell St."

13 Carried unanimously.

14 Moved by Cr. Coldicutt - Seconded by Cr. Stride:- "That the Council
 15 do now adjourn until Tuesday October 21st. inst."

16 Carried unanimously.
