

Monday - July 21st. 1913.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, July 21st. 1913, at 6.15 O'clock p.m.

Present:- His Worship Acting-Reeve Fawcett

Councillors Mac Donald, Coldicutt, Macpherson, Wayne, and Stride.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Cr. Macpherson:- "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole to re-consider the Burnaby Temporary Loan No. 2. By Law 1913."

Carried unanimously.

The Committee, on rising, reported the By Law complete.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt - Seconded by Cr. Stride:- "That the Burnaby Temporary Loan No. 2. By Law, 1913, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Cr. Macpherson:- "That the Burnaby Temporary Loan No. 2. By Law, 1913, do pass the Third Reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk, and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt - Seconded by Cr. Wayne:- "That the Release of the Richard Turner Mortgage be signed by the Reeve and Clerk and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Macpherson - Seconded by Cr. Coldicutt:- "That Provincial Road Superintendent Mc Bride be written to, asking if his department would be willing to pay the cost of oiling Royal Oak Road from the B.C.E. Ry. to the Prison Farm."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Macpherson - Seconded by Cr. Coldicutt:- "That two car loads of Oil be purchased to oil the following roads, viz:-

Sixth Street from the City limits

Edmonds Street from Sixth St. to Kingsway.

Douglas Road. - the unfinished portion

Gilmour Avenue.

and that this work be done by the Maintenance gangs."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt - Seconded by Cr. Stride:- "That the Council do now adjourn."
