3 An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal  
 4 Hall on Monday, April 28th. 1913. at 8.40 p.m.

5 Present:- His worship Reeve Mr. Fugor.  
 6 Councillors Coldicutt, Fan Vel, Mac. Donald, Macpherson, Mayne,  
 7 and Stride.

32 Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Fan Vel:- "That the  
 33 Burnaby Electric Railway By Law, 1913, do pass the Third Reading,  
 34 that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk, and the Corporate  
 35 Seal be attached thereto."

36 Carried unanimously.

37 Moved by Cr. Macpherson - Seconded by Cr. Fan Vel:- "That the Burnaby

21 Moved by Mr. Coldicutt - Seconded by Mr. Fan Vel: - "That the Burnaby

 23 do pass the Third Reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and  
 24 Clerk, and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto".

26 The Solicitor wrote, forwarding the Assent of the Lieut. Governor  
 27 in Council to By Laws Nos. 154 and 155.  
 28 Moved by Mr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Mr. Stride: - "That the letter be  
 29 received and filed".  
 30 Carried unanimously.

31 The Secretary of the Bureau of Provincial Information wrote, asking  
 32 that a brief resume of current happenings in Burnaby, might from  
 33 time to time be forwarded.

34 Moved by Mr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Mr. Fan Vel: - "That the  
 35 matter be left in the hands of the Reeve, Comptroller, and Clerk".  
 36 Carried unanimously.

37 W. Martin Dean wrote, forwarding Petition to the B.C.E.Ry. Co. for a  
 38 Station on the "Cut-off" at 18th. Avenue.

39 Moved by Mr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Mr. Macpherson: - "That this matter  
 40 be referred to the Transportation Committee"  
 41 An Amendment was

42 Moved by Mr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Mr. Stride: - "That this Council  
 43 do endorse the Petition, and forward the same to the B.C.E.Ry. Co."  
 44 On the Amendment being put, Councillor Macpherson voted Against,  
 45 and it was declared  
 46 Carried.

1 Mr. Colclough <sup>AL. M.</sup> submitted a recommendation from the  
 2 North Arm Harbour Committee that the Council send lettergrams  
 3 to the J. D. Taylor, M. P. and H. H. Stevens, M. P. at Ottawa, calling  
 4 attention to the necessity for appropriations for the purpose of  
 5 constructing a jetty at Sturgeon Bank at the mouth of the  
 6 North Arm of the Fraser River, and for two dredges for work on  
 7 that Waterway.

8 Moved by Mr. Macpherson. Seconded by Mr. Macdonald:- "That the  
 9 matter stand as it is, and this Council endorse through their  
 10 delegate to the Committee, and that this Council cannot see  
 11 its way to act individually on the matter, but that if the  
 12 Committee should send the letter, this Council will endorse  
 13 it."

14 An Amendment was

15 Moved by Mr. Fan Vel. Seconded by Mr. Stride:- "That as requested by  
 16 our Delegate to the Committee, a lettergram be sent to J. D. Taylor.  
 17 M. P. and H. H. Stevens, M. P."

18 On the Amendment being put. Councillors Colclough, Mayne, Stride,  
 19 and Fan Vel, voted in favour, and Councillors Macdonald,  
 20 and Macpherson voted against.

21 The Amendment thus became the substantive motion, and  
 22 was declared

24 Moved by Mr. Fan Vel. Seconded by Mr. Stride:- "That the Council  
 25 do now adjourn.
