

Monday - July 18th. 1913.

A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, July 18th. 1913, at 8.15 p.m.

Present: His worship Acting Reeve Van Vel.

Councillors Stride, Macpherson, Coldicutt, Mac Donald, and Wayne.

Moved by Mr. Macpherson. Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: "That the Minutes of the meetings of July 10th, 14th, and 1st, be adopted as typewritten, and confirmed, subject to the Amendment of the minute re. Mortgage, Edmonds Development Co. Ltd. (70.265/25) by substituting seven per centum for eight per centum as the rate of interest".

Carried unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

Dr. Watson - Application for leave of absence.

Moved by Mr. Macpherson. Seconded by Mr. Wayne: "That two weeks leave of absence be granted".

Carried unanimously.

Secretary, Railway Commission - Forwarding copy of Order re. G. T. R. Crossing at Phillips Avenue.

Moved by Mr. Mac Donald. Seconded by Mr. Stride: "That the letter be received and filed".

Carried unanimously.

City Clerk, Vancouver - Advising that the City of Vancouver had purchased certain property in North Burnaby, for Cemetery purposes.

Moved by Mr. Macpherson. Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: "That the Corporation Solicitors be instructed to take immediate and emphatic steps to counteract or prevent this Cemetery being placed on the site purchased by the City of Vancouver for that purpose".

Carried unanimously.

Provincial Secretary - Advising that the Lieutenant Governor in Council had appointed Councillor Angus Mac Donald as the representative of Burnaby on the Burrard Peninsula Joint Sewerage Board.

Moved by Mr. Macpherson. Seconded by Mr. Coldicutt: "That the letter be received and filed, and the appointment of Councillor Mac Donald be confirmed".

Carried unanimously.

J. H. Muir re. Bronze Medals for High School Entrance Examinations asking this Council to take steps to secure a medal for Burnaby.

Moved by Mr. Coldicutt. Seconded by Mr. Macpherson: "That the letter be endorsed, and that the Clerk write to Capt. Sladen C. M. P. private secretary to H. R. H. the Governor General, presenting the claims of Burnaby".

Carried unanimously.

F. R. Glover re. Access to Mc Gregor Station. - advising that his

16 1. That a portion of Barnet Road necessary for laying the car track
 17 on the permanent grade, be graded at a cost not exceeding \$5000.
 18 Moved by Cr. Mac Donald. Seconded by Cr. Mayne: - "That the Report of the
 19 Board of Works be adopted."

20 Carried unanimously.

21 Finance Committee Report: - Your Committee met on July 14th. inst. and
 22 recommend:-

23 1. That General Accounts, amounting to \$162.52 be paid.
 24 2. That Contract Accounts, amounting to \$23,684.04, be paid.
 25 3. That a Sixty day Renewal of the Note of C. A. Bodie & Co., be
 26 accepted.

27 Your Committee met on July 21st. inst., and recommend:-

28 1. That General Accounts, amounting to \$10,830.44, be paid.
 29 2. That Contract Accounts, amounting to \$958.18, be paid.
 30 3. That Wages, amounting to \$1113.50, be paid.
 31 4. That a Reward of the proportion of taxes on the Road Allowance
 32 in the Subdivision Plan of part of Block 9. D. L. 59. be
 33 allowed.

34 Moved by Cr. Mayne. Seconded by Cr. Macpherson: - "That the Reports
 35 of the Finance Committee be adopted."

36 Carried unanimously.

37 The Engineer submitted a report on the work necessary for
 38 clearing Brunette River.

39 Moved by Cr. Macpherson. Seconded by Cr. Mayne: - "That a copy of the
 40 Report be forwarded to the Burnaby Lake Proprietary Club, and that
 41 consideration be deferred for two weeks, in order that it may be
 42 better seen what the financial position may be, also that
 43 the Engineer ascertain & report as to the cost of taking off the
 44 water, and whether flood gates may be advisable."

45 Carried unanimously.

1 Mr. Warman attended, and addressed the Council with reference
 2 to the assessment of Lot 4, Subdivision B, Blocks 2 & 3, D.L. 96,
 3 as Unimproved, when, as he stated, a house had been standing
 4 upon the property for two years.

5 Moved by Mr. Macpherson. Seconded by Mr. Stride: - That this be
 6 referred to the Corporation Solicitors to advise whether in cases
 7 of this sort, the Council might properly allow a refund of the
 8 difference as between "Improved" and "Unimproved"; and that
 9 they be also requested to advise as to the validity of the
 10 1914 Assessment being made during 1913.

11 Carried unanimously.

12 Moved by Mr. Coldicutt. Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: - That the
 13 Assessor be instructed to submit a report as to the reason
 14 why this property was assessed as "Unimproved", when a house
 15 has been standing thereon for two years.

16 Carried unanimously.

17 Mr. Graham, of Clinton Street, attended and addressed the
 18 Council with reference to a Water Supply to his residence.

19 Moved by Mr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Mr. Macpherson: - That
 20 Councillors Mayne and Stride be a Committee to investigate this
 21 matter, and to report.


22 Carried unanimously.

25 Moved by Mr. Stride, Seconded by Mr. Mayne: - That Councillors Mayne,
 26 and Stride, with the Engineers; be a Committee to investigate
 27 this matter, and to report.
