

1 Monday - August 10th. 1914.

2 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal
 3 Hall on Monday - August 10th. 1914, at 8 o'clock, p.m.
 4 Present: - His worship Reeve Fraser.

5 Councillors Van Vel, Mac. Donald, Bevan, Allen, Rose, and Murray.
 6 Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the
 7 Minutes of the Meeting of July 24th. ult. be adopted as
 8 typewritten, and confirmed.

9 Carried unanimously.

10 The Proclamation in the B.C. Gazette, declaring a state of war to be
 11 in existence between the British Empire and Germany; was read
 12 by the Clerk, the Council standing meanwhile.

13 The National Anthem was then sung.

14 The North Fraser Harbour Commissioners, with their Secretary and
 15 Engineer, attended with reference to the North Fraser Harbour
 16 Aid By-Law. 1914.

17 Moved by Cr. Van Vel, Seconded by Cr. Rose: - "That the Standing
 18 Orders be suspended for the purpose of now considering the
 19 North Fraser Harbour Aid By-Law. 1914.

20 Chairman Abernethy and Commissioners Hodson and Yates
 21 addressed the Council.

22 Captain Boyd, through the Reeve, asked several questions of
 23 the Commissioners.

24 Mr. B.G. Walker, addressed the Council in support of the
 25 Commissioners.

26 Moved by Cr. Van Vel, Seconded by Cr. Rose: - "That the proposed
 27 Agreement be now discussed with the Commissioners".

28 Councillors Van Vel, Rose and Murray, voted in favour, and
 29 Councillor Mac. Donald, Allen and Bevan, voted against.
 30 The Reeve gave his casting vote in favour, and declared
 31 the resolution to be

32 Carried.

33 Moved by Cr. Van Vel, Seconded by Cr. Allen: - "That this Council
 34 do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole to reconsider
 35 the North Fraser Harbour Aid By-Law, 1914."

36 Carried unanimously.

37 The Agreement was then read.

38 The Commissioners stated that they could not sign the Agreement
 39 and left the Council Chamber.

40 Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Bevan: - "That in view of
 41 the present state of unrest and war in our nation, and the
 42 scarcity of money; that the North Fraser Harbour Aid By-Law, 1914,

be laid over until times are more settled, and peace is again proclaimed.

Carried

Councillors Murray and Van Vel, against.
Moved by Mr. Mac Donald. Seconded by Mr. Bevan: "That the Committee do now rise and report progress."

Carried unanimously.

Upon the suggestion of his worship the Reeve, it was moved by Mr. Bevan. Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: "That the use of the Public Hall for mobilisation purposes at any time, be offered to the B. C. Horse, free of all costs."

Carried unanimously.

Lieut. H. V. L. Macpherson, who was present, thanked the Council, on behalf of the B. C. Horse.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-
R. G. Walker, J. P. re. Geo. A. Thompson, advising that it was not his intention to proceed further with the matter.

Moved by Mr. Rose, Seconded by Mr. Murray: "That the letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

Solicitors - re. Franklin vs. Burnaby, advising having received notice of discontinuance herein.

Moved by Mr. Rose, Seconded by Mr. Allen: "That the letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

City Engineers - Vancouver, tendering thanks for the exemption from Road Tax, of the workmen employed on the Cemetery Site.
Moved by Mr. Allen, Seconded by Mr. Bevan: "That the letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

Central Ratepayers' Executive, forwarding copy of Resolution re. increased cost of necessities of life.

Moved by Mr. Rose, Seconded by Mr. Allen: "That the resolution be received and endorsed."

Carried unanimously.

Inspector of Municipalities - re. Mark Marsh mortgage, advising that no provision has been made for extension of mortgage.
Moved by ^{Mr. Rose.} The Reeve, Seconded by Mr. Allen: "That the letter be filed, and the contents noted."

Carried unanimously.

Engineer - re. Subdivision Plan, Block 2, D. L. 158, recommending that the Plan be signed on condition that the road is not to be opened up by this Corporation for 18 months.

Moved by Mr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Mr. Bevan: - "That the Report of the Engineer be adopted."

Carried unanimously.
