3 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal
 4 Hall on Monday, July 13th. 1914, at 8 o'clock, p.m.

5 Present:- His worship Reeve Fraser.

6 Councillors Mac Donald, Rose, Allen, Bevan, and Murray.

7 Mr. Van Vel arrived later.

8 Moved by Mr. Rose, Seconded by Mr. Allen: - "That the Minutes
 9 of the Meetings of June 29th ult. and July 6th. inst. be
 10 adopted as typewritten, and confirmed."

11 Carried unanimously.

12 Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

13 Solicitors re. Webster Contract enclosing copy of letter from
 14 Bowser, Reid and Wallbridge.

15 Moved by Mr. Rose, Seconded by Mr. Allen: - "That consideration
 16 be deferred, until a copy of the letter from Bowser, Reid and
 17 Wallbridge to the Solicitors under date of July 2nd inst. is
 18 received, together with a report from the Solicitors on the
 19 whole matter".

20 Carried unanimously.

 contracts.
