

Tuesday - May 26th. 1914.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Tuesday, May 26th, 1914, at 10 O'clock p. m.

Present: His worship Reeve Fraser

Councillors Allen, Murray, Mac Donald, Fauvel, and Bevan.

The Solicitors wrote, forwarding copy of draft Order-in-Council re. the Riverway Diversion By Law, 1914, and recommended that the By Law be finally passed.

Moved by Cr. Fauvel, Seconded by Cr. Allen: - "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole to reconsider the Riverway Diversion By Law, 1914".

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Fauvel, Seconded by Cr. Mac Donald: - "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete".

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Cr. Fauvel: - "That the Riverway Diversion By Law¹⁹¹⁴ be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Fauvel, Seconded by Cr. Bevan: - "That the Riverway Diversion By Law, 1914, do pass the Third Reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk, and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

The Solicitors wrote, advising as to the meeting of the Executive Council re. Knapway Contract, to the effect that the Premier expressed his determination to see that the money voted for Knapway was expended thereon and not paid to creditors of the Canadian Mineral Rubber Co. in Eastern Canada.

Moved by Cr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Cr. Bevan: - "That the report of the deputation be received."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Cr. Bevan: - "That this Council do now adjourn."
