2 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal
 3 Hall on Monday, June 29th. 1914 at 8 O'clock p.m.
 4 Present: His Worship Reve Fraser.
 5 Councillors McDonald, Murray, Allen, Bevan, Rose, and Fawcett.
 6 Moved by Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Allen: That the Minutes of
 7 the Meetings of June 15th. and 22nd. inst. be adopted as
 8 typewritten, and confirmed.

19 Carried unanimously.

11 Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

12 Dr. Watson - Advising that Mrs. Thomson of Harris Strab. North
 13 Burnaby had been removed to the Vancouver General Hospital,
 14 suffering from Typhoid Fever. He also enclosed two letters from
 15 Dr. Bapty of the Provincial Board of Health on the subject of
 16 Typhoid Fever Prevention by Inoculation.
 17 Moved by Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. McDonald: "That the letter
 18 be received and filed, and the action of Dr. Watson be
 19 confirmed."

21 Solicitors - re Overcrowding of Burnaby Lake cars enclosing copy

23 Mr. Fawcett complimented the Reve and the Corporation
 24 Solicitor on the good work accomplished by them.

 72 Department would pay for the cost of oiling the portion of
 73 Riverway through D.L. 172.

- 75 Councillor Rose gave Notice of Motion to introduce an Amending
 76 By-Law to the Burnaby Revenue By-Law 1914 for the purpose
 77 of extending the rebate period until August 17th. 1914.
 78 The Engineer asked for authority to act with Councillor Murray
 79 for the purpose of opening and tabulating the Tenders for
 80 Steel Pipe in readiness for the Water Committee at their
 81 Meeting on Monday, July 6th.

- 82 Moved by Mr. Fawcett, seconded by Mr. MacDonald: "That
 83 the necessary authority be and is hereby given."

84 Carried unanimously.

- 85 Moved by Mr. Bevan, seconded by Mr. Rose: "That this
 86 Council are strongly opposed to the landing in British
 87 Columbia of the Hindoo now on board the S.S. Komagata
 88 and generally to the immigration of all ^{and particularly} Indians
 89 from ~~Asia~~ Canada and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded
 90 to Colonel Taylor, M.P.
