2                                  An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the  
3                                  Municipal Hall on Monday, January 5th, 1914, at 11-30 a.m.  
4                                  Present:- His worship Reeve Mr. Gregor.

5                                  Councillors MacDonald, Macpherson, Van Vel, Coldicutt, Mayne,  
6                                  and Stride.

7                                  The C.M.C. of Richmond, wrote asking if cheque for \$3000 being  
8                                  the first payment on account of the adjustment of Burnaby  
9                                  Southwark Boundary, might be forwarded.

10                                 The Solicitor advised that this payment would not become  
11                                 due until after the passing of the validating Act.

12                                 Moved by Cr. Coldicutt. Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- That the Clerk  
13                                 notify the Corporation of Richmond in accordance with the advice  
14                                 of the Solicitor.

15                                 Carried unanimously.

16                                 The Secretary, Edmonds Ratepayers' Association wrote re. Annual  
17                                 Meeting.

18                                 A delegation from this Association was in attendance, and  
19                                 addressed the Council on the same matter.

20                                 Moved by Cr. Coldicutt. Seconded by Cr. Macpherson:- That if it is  
21                                 at all possible to get out the Annual Statement of Accounts,  
22                                 an Annual Meeting be held on a date to be fixed by the  
23                                 Council.

24                                 Carried unanimously.

25                                 The Solicitors wrote, forwarding copy of letter written by  
26                                 themselves to Mr. Boak re. claim of J. W. Barnett.

27                                 Moved by Cr. Macpherson. Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- That the letter  
28                                 be received and filed, and the action of the Solicitors be  
29                                 confirmed.

30                                 Carried unanimously.

31                                 The Solicitors advised that the documents in connection with  
32                                 the Road Allowance through Block 10, D.L. 91-central, were  
33                                 in order.

34                                 The Engineer reported that the Road Allowance was necessary  
35                                 in accordance with the Subdivision Plan of Block 9. D.L. 91. C.

36                                 Moved by Cr. Van Vel. Seconded by Cr. Macpherson:- That the Quit  
37                                 Claim be accepted.

38                                 Carried unanimously.

39                                 The Solicitors forwarded for Execution, Quit-Claim deeds in  
40                                 duplicate - Burnaby to Lambert Bond, and Burnaby to Alberta  
41                                 Financial Corporation.

42                                 Moved by Cr. Van Vel, Macpherson, Seconded by Cr. Stride:- That the  
43                                 several Quit claim deeds be signed by the Reeve and Clerk, and  
44                                 the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Fan Vel, Seconded by Cr. Coldicutt: - "That the Annual Reports lay on the Table for one week."

Carried unanimously.

The Engineer submitted a Report re. clearing Roads in Blocks 54 and 55, D. L. 88., and recommended that the request of W. Stortan for re-imbursement, be not granted.

Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the Report of the Engineer be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

The Engineer reported that the owners of Blocks 54 and 55 D. L. 31 were prepared to convey to this Corporation a parcel of land 132' wide, exclusive of the 33' road allowance, on the westerly side of Blocks 54. and 55, north of Barnet Road, and such land south of Barnet Road as may be necessary to be with the other parcel, equal to the area of the Streets proposed to be cancelled in Blks. 54 and 55.

Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Macpherson: - "That the Report of the Engineer be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Fan Vel, Seconded by Cr. Macpherson: - "That candidates for the Reevship be allowed ten free copies of the Voters' List, candidates for Commeillors and School Trustee five free copies, and any ratepayer applying for it, one free copies; all extra copies to be paid for at the rate of two Dollars per. copy."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Cr. Mayne: - "That this Council desire to express their deepest sympathy and regret for the recent heavy bereavement sustained by W. G. Mc. Quarrie in the death of his father."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Cr. Macpherson: - "That subject to the approval of the Chief Constable, one week's leave of absence be granted to Constable Dodge."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Cr. Mac. Donald: - "That this Council do now adjourn until Thursday January 8th. inst. at 10.30. a.m."
