7 Moved by Cr. Rose, Seconded by Cr. Allen: - "That the Minutes of
8 the Meeting of March 23rd. ult. be adopted as typewritten,
9 and confirmed."

10 Carried unanimously.

11 Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

12 F. D. Elkins - Application for one year's extension of Gaerdes
13 Mortgage.

14 Moved by Cr. Allen, Seconded by Cr. Rose: - "That one year's extension
15 be granted, and the Corporation Solicitors instructed to prepare
16 the necessary document."

17 Carried unanimously.
