3 An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the
4 Municipal Hall on Monday, January 4th, 1915, at 12.30 p.m.
5 Present:- His worship Reece Fraser.
6 Councillors Allen, Murray, Fauvel, Bevan, and MacDonald.
7 Moved by Mr. Fauvel, Seconded by Mr. Allen:- "That this
8 Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole to
9 reconsider the Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By Law 1912,
10 Amendment By Law, 1914."

11 Carried unanimously.

12 Moved by Mr. Allen, Seconded by Mr. Murray:- "That the
13 Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete
14 without amendment."

15 Carried unanimously.

16 Moved by Mr. Fauvel, Seconded by Mr. Murray:- "That the
17 Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By Law 1912, Amendment
18 By Law 1914, be read a Third time."

19 Carried unanimously.

20 Moved by Mr. Fauvel, Seconded by Mr. Bevan:- "That the
21 Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By Law 1912, Amendment
22 By Law 1914, do pass the Third Reading, that it be signed
23 by the Reece and Clerk, and the Corporate Seal be
24 affixed thereto."

25 Carried unanimously.

26 The Inspector of Trams wrote, stating that the
27 Attorney General advised, that the B. C. R. Co. were
28 discriminating by the issue of Apprentice Tickets.

29 Moved by Mr. Fauvel, Seconded by Mr. MacDonald:- "That a
30 copy of the letter be sent to the Central Ratepayers' Executive."

31 Carried unanimously.

32 The Clerk submitted Requisitions for sundry repairs to the
33 Municipal Autos.

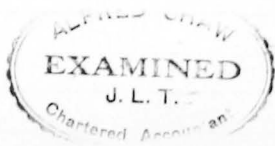
34 Moved by Mr. Fauvel, Seconded by Mr. MacDonald:- "That the
