4 Municipal Hall on Monday, November 8th. 1915, at 8 p.m.  
5 Present:- His worship Reeve Fraser.

6 Councillors Fan Vel, MacDonald, Coldicutt, Bevan, Ward, and  
7 Murray.

8 Moved by Mr. Fan Vel, Seconded by Mr. Ward:- "That the Minutes  
9 of the Meeting of October 25th. ult. be adopted as written  
10 and confirmed."

11 Carried unanimously.

12 Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-  
13 Secretary - Civilian Rifle Association. "Thanks for work on  
14 Rifle Range."

15 Moved by Mr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Mr. Bevan:- "That the  
16 letter be received and filed."

17 Carried unanimously.

18 Solicitors - re. Robinson vs. Burnaby, advising that the  
19 Appeal by the Plaintiff herein had been dismissed  
20 with costs.

21 Moved by Mr. Bevan, Seconded by Mr. Ward:- "That the letter  
22 be received and filed."

23 Carried unanimously.

24 Solicitors - re Canadian Northern Pacific Railway appeal.  
25 advising that the Appeal against the decision of Mr.  
26 Justice Clement confirming the action of the Court of Revision  
27 had been dismissed with costs.

28 Moved by Mr. Macdonald, Seconded by Mr. Murray:- "That the  
29 letter be received and filed, and the Solicitors be thanked  
30 for their good work."

5. That the Bridge on Broadway, near Douglas Road, be closed to traffic.

6. That the Corporation Solicitors be instructed to oppose the application, before the Board of Railway Commissioners, of the U.V. & E. Ry. re. North Road.

7. That the Corporation Solicitors be instructed to object on behalf of Burnaby re. Interference with North Road (inter-municipal) by the U.V. & E. Ry.

 3 the matter of the proposed cut and Bridge on the  
 4 North Road.  
 5 Mayor Gray, with Councillor Jardine, and engineer  
 6 Blackman, of New Westminster, and  
 7 Reeve Marmont, with Councillors Whiting and Philip,  
 8 of Coquitlam, were also present in the same connection.  
 9 The Corporation Solicitor strongly advised that the  
 10 proposals of the Railway Company be not entertained.  
 11 Moved by Mr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Mr. Bevan: "That the  
 12 engineer and Mr. Bevan meet the G. R. Ry. engineer on  
 13 the ground & also invite New Westminster and Coquitlam  
 14 to send representatives to such meeting, and to  
 15 report back to this Council."
