letter be received, and filed."

Sales Engineer, B.C. Electric Rly. Co. - acknowledging our letter  
of August 3rd, 1915 re. lighting along Riverway from Gillis  
Avenue to 10th. Avenue, stating this would receive their best  
attention.

Whole to re-consider the Hastings-Barnet Road Diversion  
By-Law, 1915."

Committee do now rise, and report the By-Law complete."

Moved by br. Goldieutt, seconded by br. Bevan: "That the  
Hastings-Barnet Road Diversion By-Law 1915 be read a  
third time."

Moved by br. Saw Vel, seconded by br. Murray: "That the  
Hastings-Barnet Road Diversion By-Law 1915 do pass the third  
reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk, and the  
Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Council do now adjourn."
