

Monday, January 10th, 1916.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, January 10th, 1916, at 8.40 O'clock p.m.

Present:- His worship Reeve Fraser.

Councillors Faulvel, Coldicutt, Murray, MacDonald, Ward, and Bevan.

The Reeve stated that he was informed that Mrs Mitchell had lost her Certificate of Title in the recent fire at her home, and that a Deater had been sent to her, from the Municipal Stores.

Moved by Cr. Faulvel, Seconded by Cr. Coldicutt:- "That every assistance be given to replace the Certificate of Title, and that the gift of a Deater be confirmed."

Carried unanimously.

Cr. MacDonald called attention to the case of Mrs Beek, of Harris St. & Esmond Ave.

Moved by Cr. MacDonald, Seconded by Cr. Faulvel:- "That this be referred to the Chief Constable."

Carried unanimously.

The Clerk reported that the Assessor had duly returned the 1916 Assessment Roll of the Municipality on January 10th, 1916.

Moved by Cr. Faulvel, Seconded by Cr. MacDonald:- "That the 1916 Assessment Roll be and is hereby received."

Carried unanimously.

The Reeve, as Chairman of the Board of Police Commissioners, submitted a Report on the work of the Police Department for the year 1915.

Moved by Cr. Faulvel, Seconded by Cr. Ward:- "That the Report be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Cr. Faulvel:- "That this Council do now adjourn."
