2 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the  
3 Municipal Hall on Monday, May 22nd. 1916, at 7.15 p.m.

7 Moved by Mr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Mr. Murray:- "That the

9 confirmed."

10 Carried unanimously.

11 Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

12 The Premier, re. Employment of Returned Soldiers, advising  
13 that the Government would give careful consideration  
14 to the proposal to employ returned soldiers on Crown  
15 Lands in Burnaby.

19 J. Fyfe Smith - Invitation to attend a meeting for
