 Councillors Young, Russell and Lawson voted in favour, and  
 Councillors Edgar, Garin and Rummel, with the Reeve,  
 voted against.

The Amendment was declared

 four weeks."

2. The Reeve submitted a recommendation that the protest  
 against the proposed Collierywood Valley Sewer, be  
 withdrawn.

Moved by Mr. Russell, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: "That the  
 recommendation be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: "That this  
 Council do now adjourn."
