

Monday - March 10th. 1924.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, March 10th. 1924, at 8-30p.m.

Present:- His Worship Reeve W. Lear.

Councillors Neville, Garin, Rummel, Edgar, Campbell, Murray, and Longley.

1. Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Longley:- "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to reconsider the Burnaby Town Planning By Law No. 1. 1924."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Longley:- "That the Committee rise, and recommend the adoption of the principle of Town Planning, and that the necessary By Law be drafted for the next meeting."

Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Campbell:- "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to reconsider the Burnaby Town Planning By Law, No. 2. 1924."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Garin:- "That the Committee rise and recommend the adoption of the principle of Town Planning, and that the necessary By Law be prepared for the next meeting."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

3. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to re-consider the Glen Lyon Country Club Agreement By Law. 1924."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Garin:- "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete, without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Longley:- "That the Glen Lyon Country Club Agreement By Law. 1924, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Garin:- "That the Glen Lyon Country Club Agreement By Law, 1924, do pass the Third Reading,"

that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk; and
that the corporate Seal be affixed thereto.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - "That this
Council do now adjourn."
