

TUESDAY - AUGUST 18th. 1925.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Tuesday August 18th 1925 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve McLean.

Councillors Smith, Hall, Rummel, Gibbs, and Engberg.

Major Taylor, District Engineer, Public Works Department attended and the question of the re-construction of four bridges on the Easterly end of the Hastings-Barnet Road was fully discussed.

Moved by Cr. Smith, Seconded by Cr. Hall: "That this Council endorse the proposal to re-construct four wooden bridges and also approves the acceptance of the lowest tender received by the Department of Public Works."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Hall, Seconded by Cr. Engberg: "That in view of the estimated cost of detours, Burnaby is not prepared to assume amount thereof unless financial assistance be forthcoming from parties affected by the closing of the Hastings-Barnet Road."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Engberg, Seconded by Cr. Hall: "That the Committee appointed to delimit the fire area for the southern portion of the Municipality be asked to submit a report on Monday next, August 24th inst."

Carried unanimously

Moved by Cr. Smith, Seconded by Cr. Hall: "That this Council do now adjourn."
