

Monday October 18th, 1926.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, October 18th, 1926 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve McLean in the Chair.

Councillors: Gray, Hall, Moore, Planche and Engberg.

Messrs McQuarrie, Whiteside and Duncan wrote advising that this Council had no power to amend the Burnaby subdivisions By-law to compel owners to clear and rough grade lanes in proposed subdivisions.

Moved by Cr.Moore, Seconded by Cr.Hall: "That the letter be received and filed"

Carried unanimously.

1. The City of Vancouver submitted formal application for approval of District Lots 143 and 148 for use as Cemetery.

Moved by Cr.Engberg, Seconded by Cr.Hall: "That a Committee of three be appointed to confer with the City Council on this matter."

Carried unanimously.

His Worship the Reeve named Councillor Engberg, the Clerk and himself as the committee.

Moved by Cr.Engberg, Seconded by Cr.Planche: "That this Council do now resolve into a committee of the whole with the Reeve in the Chair to reconsider the Grandview Highway Dedication By-law 1926."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Engberg, Seconded by Cr.Planche: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Cr. Engberg, Seconded by Cr.Planche: "That the Grandview Highway Dedication By-law 1926 be now read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Engberg, Seconded by Cr.Planche: "That the Grandview Highway Dedication By-law 1926 do pass the Third reading that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Moved by Cr. Moore, Seconded by Cr. Gray: "That the transfer be approved subject to Agreement - Durnaby and Hopper and assignment Hopper to Hopper being released."

3. The Municipal Clerk presents petition for construction of 4' cement sidewalk on Fell Avenue, duly certified to as to sufficiency.

Moved by Cr. Moore, Seconded by Cr. Planche: "That the petition be received and the Engineer requested to bring down estimate of cost,"

Carried unanimously.

- X 4. W. F. Bishop applied to have portion of Lot 1, SD 45-46, Blk. 2, D. L. 96 released from agreement for sale covering the whole lot and that conveyance be given for the portion referred to. The Treasurer advised that release and conveyance would be in order on payment of sum of \$35.00

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Hall: "That portion be released on receipt of report from the Property Salesman and that the Reeve and the Clerk be and are hereby instructed to sign conveyance and affix the Corporate seal thereto."

5. Moved by Cr. Planche, Seconded by Cr. Gray: "That a permit be granted to the Vancouver Heights Lawn Tennis Club to hold a dance in the Masonic Hall on Saturday, October 30th, 1926."
