

Monday - October 4th, 1926.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, October 4th, 1926 at 8.00 o'clock a.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve McLean in the Chair.

Councillors Gray, Hall, Moore, Planche and Engberg.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. City Clerk, Vancouver, advising that City Council of Vancouver had resolved to make formal application for approval of cemetery site in Ward 3, Burnaby.

Moved by Cr.Engberg, Seconded by Cr.Gray: "That this matter be further considered on receipt of formal application from the City of Vancouver and that the City be so advised."

Carried unanimously.

2. The Special Committee re Sewerage Area for the Central Park and West Burnaby areas submitted a recommendation that Messrs Hermon and Hermon be retained, to make a survey of the district and to delimit the boundaries of the proposed system, on a basis of $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the Estimated cost of the scheme.

Moved by Cr.Moore, Seconded by Cr.Engberg: "That the recommendation of the special committee be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

3. The Municipal Clerk presented petition from residents of Warwick Avenue asking for a cement sidewalk under the Local Improvement Act duly certified to as to sufficiency.

Moved by Cr.Moore, Seconded by Cr.Planche: "That the Municipal Engineer be requested to submit estimate of cost of proposed walks by Monday next."

Carried unanimously.

4. Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr.Engberg: "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole with the Reeve in the Chair to reconsider the Mary A Scott Property Purchase By-law 1926."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Engberg: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."
