

Tuesday - April 19th, 1927

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Tuesday April 19th, 1927 at 7. 30 p..m.

Present: His Worship Reeve Bell in the chair.

Councillors. West, Gray, Lambert, Moore, Planche, Willson and Hill.

The Chief Constable submitted a suggestion that provision be made in the Street Traffic Regulation By-law to prohibit parking opposite theatres, etc.

Moved by Cr.Moore, Seconded by Cr.Hill: "That this suggestion be referred to the Solicitor."

Carried unanimously,

R.P.Clark and Company Vancouver Limited wrote suggesting that the words "for good and sufficient reason" be inserted after the word "sale" in the third line of paragraph 13 of the agreement re sale of tax sale lands.

Moved by Cr.Willson, Seconded by Cr.West: "That the letter be received and filed."

Moved by Cr.Planche, Seconded by Cr.Willson: "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the whole with the Reeve in the chair to reconsider the R. .Clark & Company (Vancouver) Limited, Agreement Authorization By-law 1927."

Moved by Cr.Hill, Seconded by Cr.West: "That paragraph 13 of the agreement be amended by adding after the word "sale" in the third line thereof the words " for good and sufficient reason"

Moved by Cr. Planche, Seconded by Cr.Willson: "That the R.P.Clark & Company (Vancouver) Limited Agreement Authorization By-law 1927 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."
