

Monday - May 21st, 1928.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was Held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, May 21st, 1928 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve McLean in the chair.

Councillors West, Gray, Lambert, Pritchard, Planche Shewbrooks and Wilson.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Gray: "That the matter of the Ramsay lease be laid over for one week."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Pritchard, Seconded by Cr. Shewbrooks: "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the whole with the Reeve in the chair to reconsider the Grandview Plans Cancellation By-law No. 2. 1928."

Carried unanimously.

The Clerk submitted report on petition re elimination of certain sections of the West Burnaby Sewer work.

Mr. Bell of Buckingham and Bell attended and addressed the Council on this matter. The Solicitors wrote advising that approval of Provincial Board of Health should be obtained as to any changes.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Pritchard: "That the request of the petitioners, namely that the following sections of sewer construction be not proceeded with be acceded to:

Smith Avenue from Burke Street to Price Street
 Price Street from Smith Avenue West 700'
 Bell Avenue from Woodland Street north.
 Woodland Street from Smith Avenue to Bell Avenue
 Chesham Avenue from Burke Street north.

Carried - Reeve McLean and Cr.West against.

The Clerk submitted petitions received for construction of cement sidewalks, together with certificates as follows:

Moved by Cr.Planche, Seconded by Cr.West: "That the petitions and the certificates of the Clerk be received and filed and that the Engineer be requested to bring down report and estimate under the Local Improvement Act."

Moved by Cr.West, Seconded by Cr.Gray: "That Cr.Gray place on the table affidavits referred to re N.Casco contract for check by the Treasurer."

Carried unanimously.
