Moved by Cr. West, Seconded by Cr. Shewbrooks: "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the whole with the Reeve in the chair to reconsider the Local Improvement Construction By-law No. 32. 1928."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.West, Seconded by Or.Shewbrooks: "That the Committee do now rise andreport the By-law complete without amendment."

Carried unanimously.
