

Monday November 25th.1929.

An Adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, November 25th.1929 at 7.30 p.m.

Present Acting Reeve Lambert in the chair.

Councillors West, Rylett, Pritchard, Wheatley, Shewbrooks and Wilson.

Moved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr.West: "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole with the Acting Reeve in the chair to reconsider the Local Improvement Costs Reduction By-law 1929."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr.West: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr.West: "That the Local Improvement Costs Reduction By-law 1929 be now read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr.West: "That the Local Improvement Costs Reduction By-law 1929 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

Willard Equipment Coy. wrote advising that they could make delivery of the 12" pipe tendered on on November 18th inst. from stock and give immediate delivery. Moved by Cr.Shewbrooks, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

The Committee re tenders for supply of 12" pipe submitted tabulation of tenders received and recommended that the tender of Evans, Coleman Evans, for Stanton Iron Works Cast Iron amounting to \$7,590.00 - delivery in 9 weeks - be accepted. Moved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr. Wilson: "That the recommendation of the Committee be adopted."

Lost - Crs. Pritchard, Wilson and Acting Reeve Lambert voting against in favour. Councillors West, Rylett, Wheatley and Shewbrooks voting against.

Moved by Cr.Shewbrooks, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the tender of the Willard Equipment Coy. for supply of British Mannesman Seamless Steel Pipe out of stock for sum of \$7,170.00 be accepted."

Carried - Crs. Pritchard, Wilson and Acting Reeve Lambert against

Moved by Cr. Rylett, Seconded by Cr.Shewbrooks: "That the Contract Burnaby and Willard Equipment Coy. for supply of 3000 feet 12" British Mannesman Seamless Steel pipe for sum of \$7,170.00 be signed by the Acting Reeve and the Clerk and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Carried - Acting Reeve Lambert and Crs.Wilson and Pritchard voting against.

The report of the Engineer re estimate for proposed waterworks by-law was then discussed.

Moved by Cr.West, Seconded by Cr.Shewbrooks: "That the report be referred back for retabulation and revision."

Carried unanimously.

The Engineer submitted reports and estimates under the Local Improvement act on petitions for cement concrete sidewalks as follows:

6' N Side Kingsway. York Ave. to Miller Ave.	Total cost	\$659.87

Moved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the estimates be received and filed and that the Clerk be requested to prepare necessary By-laws."

Carried unanimously.

Secretary, Board of School Trustees wrote requesting the setting of a date on which to receive an estimate of supplementary extra-ordinary expenditure for this year.

Moved by Cr.Rylett, Seconded by Cr.West: "That the 2nd Day of December, 1929 at 7.30 p.m. be set as the date to receive this estimate of extraordinary expenditure."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Pritchard: "That this Council express the view that we believe the Government should give relief from taxation on the landowner immediately, and that we further express the view that the responsibility for raising the funds to give that relief rests entirely with the Government," both Dominion and Provincial."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the Clerk be and is hereby requested to bring in report showing status of by-laws which it is proposed to submit at the forthcoming election."

Carried unanimously.

The Council then adjourned.
