

Monday - April 29th, 1929.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, April 29th, 1929 at 10 o'clock p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve Burdick, in the chair.

Councillors West, Rylett, Lambert, Pritchard, Wheatley, Shewbrooks and Wilson:

The Terminal City Iron Works Ltd wrote advising that they could not see their way to accept contract for part of the tender on special castings, valves, valve boxes and hydrants, as they considered their tender was for the whole of the supplies only.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That the resolution passed by the Council on Monday, April 22nd inst. relating to awarding of contract to Letsen and Burpee and the Terminal City Ironworks Ltd be rescinded."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Shewbrooks, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That the tender of the Terminal City Iron Works Ltd for the whole of the supplies be accepted."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. West: "That this Council do now adjourn."
