A delegation of residents of Burnaby south &T Marine Drive attended and addressed the Council re nuisance arising from caws being permitted to your at large on the flats and also as to the hunting menace.

Moved by Cr.West, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the Engineer be asked to investigate the matter of damage by straying cattle with a view to instituting agtion against owners of cattle to recover damages."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. West, Seconded by Cr. Rylett: "That the Game Warden be asked to make a closed area of that portion of EUrnaby lying south of Marine Drive."

Carried unanimously.

Meved by Cr. Writchard, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That the Glenburn Branch Canadian Legion be granted permission to hold Boxing bouts at amoker being held at Legion Hall North Burnaby on July 9th inst." Carried unanimously. Moved by Cr.West, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That a refund of the amount paid by J.Martin for Trades license to July 15th inst. be made."
