

Monday - April 28th. 1930:

The Council met as a Committee of the Whole on Monday April 28th. 1930 at 6.45 p.m. at the Municipal Hall.

Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.

Councillors Smith, Shaw, Lambert, Edwards, Wheatley, Shewbrooks and Wilson.

Moved by Cr. Smith, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That a Ballot be taken for position as Municipal Engineer on applications of Messrs Davidson, McPherson, and McDiarmid."

An amendment was Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Shaw: "That the ballot be taken on applications of Messrs Davidson and McPherson only."

The amendment was declared Lost - Crs. Lambert and Shaw voting in favour - His Worship the Reeve and Councillors Smith, Edwards, Wheatley, Shewbrooks and Wilson voting against.

The motion was then put and Negatived - Councillors Smith, Edwards, Wheatley and Shewbrooks voting in favour - Councillors Shaw, Lambert and Wilson and His Worship Reeve Pritchard voting against.

Moved by Cr. Smith, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That Mr. S.S. MacDiarmid be appointed Municipal Engineer."

His Worship the Reeve ruled this resolution out of order.

Councillor Wilson appealed against the ruling of the chair.

The Clerk put the question "Shall the Chair be sustained."

Councillors Shaw, Lambert and Edwards voting in favour - Councillors Wheatley, Shewbrooks, Wilson and Smith voted against.

The motion was then put and negatived - Reeve Pritchard, Councillors Shaw, Lambert and Edwards voting against. Councillors Smith, Wheatley, Shewbrooks and Wilson voting in favour.

Moved by Cr. Shaw, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That Mr. John Davidson be appointed Municipal Engineer."

Moved by Cr.Wheatley, Seconded by Cr.Edwards: "That Burnaby Land Sale By-law No.5.1930 do pass the Second reading."
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That this Council do now resolve into a committee of the whole with the Reeve in the chair to reconsider Burnaby Revenue By-law 1930 Amendment By-law 1930."
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Wheatley, Seconded by Cr.Edwards: "That the Committee do now rise and report the by-law complete without amendment."
Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That Burnaby Revenue By-law 1930 be now read a Third time."
Amendment By-law 1930. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That Burnaby Revenue By-law 1930 Amendment By-law 1930 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto."
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Edwards, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1930 be lifted from the table."
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Edwards, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1930 be introduced and read a first time."
Carried - Crs.Wilson and Lambert against.

Moved by Cr.Edwards, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the Burnaby Indemnity By-law 1930 do pass the first reading."
Negatived - Crs.Smith, Shewbrooks, Lambert and Wilson voting against.

His Worship the Reeve gave notice of his intention to appoint a Municipal Engineer forthwith.

Moved by Cr.Smith, Seconded by Cr.Wilson: "That this Council do now adjourn."
Carried unanimously.
