The Williams Steel & Concrete Coy. Ltd. wrote requesting the Council to amend the Burnaby Building By-law to permit of the erection of concrete block chimneys.

Moved by Cr. Wheatley, Seconded by Cr. Edwards: "That the Engineer be instructed to have burning, etc. carried out at Confederation Park provided funds are available, and that the Engineer and Treasurer bring down statement showing details of expenditures in the various Parks to date."

Moved by Cr. Shaw, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the application of Dr. Ballard for permission to erect and operate an abattoir on property situate on Byrne Road be laid over for discussion at a meeting of the Local Board of Health to be held on Friday next."

Moved by Cr. Smith, Seconded by Cr. Edwards: "That this Council do now adjourn until 7.30 o'clock P.M. Friday, October 3rd, 1930."
