A Regular meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, May 5th. 1930 at 7.30 o'clock p.m.  
Present: His Worship Reeve Fritchard in the chair.  
Councillors Smith, Shaw, Lambert, Edwards, Wheatley, Shewbrooks and Wilson.

Moved by Cr. Smith, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That the minutes of the meeting of April 22nd ultimo be adopted and written and confirmed."  
Carried unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

W. Ross - requesting cancellation of lane at rear of Lots "A" & "B" Block 33, D.L. 34.

Moved by Cr. Shewbrooks, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That this matter be referred to the Engineer for report."  
Carried unanimously.

Childrens Aid Society of Vancouver - Campaign Committee- requesting assistance in their drive for funds.

Moved by Cr. Wilson, Seconded by Cr. Edwards: "That the letter be received and filed and the Association be advised of the policy of the Council in this connection."  
Carried unanimously.

Sec. S.E. Burnaby Ward 3 Ratepayers Association - requesting that the old building on Block 9, D.L. 13 Armstrong Avenue be handed over to the association to be re-erected on the Community Hall site - Cumberland Road, and also requesting that a committee be named to meet their Hall committee at an early date.

His Worship the Reeve submitted a report advising that he had appointed Mr. S.S. MacDairmid as Municipal Engineer and that Mr. MacDairmid had at first accepted the position but had subsequently withdrawn his acceptance. His Worship submitted copies of correspondence and telegrams between himself and Mr. MacDairmid. His Worship then reported that he had appointed Mr. John Davidson and requested confirmation of his action.

Mr. MacDairmid attended and explained to the Council his reasons for not accepting the position.

- 4' South side of Cambridge St. from Ingleton Ave. to MacDonald Ave. and upon East side of Ingleton Ave. from Cambridge St. to lane south of Cambridge St. and upon West side of MacDonald Ave. from Cambridge St. to lane south. \$ 909.96
- 4' South side of Eton St. from Ingleton Ave to Esmond Ave, and upon the east side of Esmond Ave. from Eton St to lane south of Eton Street. \$ 747.48

3. Boundaries of proposed oval to be defined by ditch cut to divert water from Football ground.
4. Softball diamond to be graded off east of Football ground.
5. Quoit pitch to be graded off north of Football ground.

Moved by Cr. Edwards, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the recommendations of the Engineer be adopted."

The Special Committee re Wehr Grader No. 2. submitted recommendation that repairs be executed to cost approximately \$305.00

Moved by Cr. Wheatley, Seconded by Cr. Wilson: "That the recommendation of the Committee be adopted."

4. The Building Inspector and M.H.O. submitted recommendation that the owner of the Hollywood Auto camp be permitted to remodel the old dance hall on these premises to make same into a four suite apartment.
