A Regular meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, April 7th. 1930 at 7.30 o'clock p.m.  
Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.  
Councillors Smith, Shaw, Lambert, Wheatley, Edwards, Shewbrooks and Wilson.

"All cast iron pipe shall be true to line and bore and of uniform thickness and free from blow-holes, cracks or other construction defects.

"All cast iron pipes and fittings shall be coated at the factory while clean, with linseed oil containing only sufficient thinning ingredient so as to thoroughly penetrate the pores of such cast iron.

"Such pipes and fittings shall, however, be given the added protection of pitch or asphaltum should the Plumbing Inspector in his opinion deem such protection necessary for house drains laid in filled ground."
