

Monday - April 13th. 1931.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, April 13th. 1931 at 7.30 p.m.
Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.
Councillors Martin, Rylett, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Wilson.

The special committee re tenders for alterations submitted amended statement of tenders received giving information as to whether tenderers are ratepayers or not. Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Lench: "That the report be referred back to the committee for information as to what Burnaby labor would be employed in each case."

Negatived - Crs. Wilson, Rylett, Wheatley and Gray voting against.

The Engineer submitted report on application of W.T. Hireen for approval of plan of Crescent Park Auto Camp, advising that the plan as submitted did not come within the provisions of the Burnaby Health By-law, and recommending that the applicant be requested to submit an amended plan in conformity with the said By-law for ten cabins only. Moved by Cr. Wheatley, Seconded by Cr. Wilson: "That the recommendation of the Engineer be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

The Engineer submitted reports and estimates under section 30 of the local improvement act on petitions for cement concrete sidewalks as follows:

4' North side of Georgia St. from Ingleton Avenue to Macdonald Avenue and upon East side of Ingleton Avenue from Georgia St. to lane north of Georgia Street and upon West side of Macdonald Ave. from Georgia St. to lane north of Georgia St.

4' South side of Edinburgh St. from Boundary Road to Esmond Avenue, and upon the West side of Esmond Avenue from Edinburgh St. to lane south of Edinburgh Street

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That the reports be received and filed and that the Clerk be instructed to bring down construction by-laws."

Carried unanimously.

The Engineer submitted request for leave of absence to attend examination final of Board of Corporation of B.C. Land Surveyors at Victoria on 14th and 15th insts.

Moved by Cr. Rylett, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That leave of absence be granted."

Carried - Cr. Wilson against.

The Clerk submitted petition and certificate of sufficiency praying for construction of cement concrete sidewalks as follows:

4' South side Oxford St. from Madison Avenue to Rosser Avenue, and upon East side Madison Ave. from Oxford St. to lane south of Oxford St. and upon West side of Rosser Ave. from Oxford St. to lane south of Oxford St.

4' South side of Parker Ave. from Esmond Ave. to Ingleton Ave. and upon the East side Esmond Ave. from Parker St. to lane south of Parker Street and upon West side of Ingleton Ave. from Parker St. to lane south of Parker St.

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That the petitions and certificates be received and filed and the Engineer be instructed to submit report and estimate under Section 30 of the Local Improvement Act."

Carried unanimously.

The B.C. Electric Power & Gas Coy. submitted application for approval of plan of gas line on Montrose Street to supply North Vancouver with gas service. The Engineer submitted recommendation that permission be granted the Company to construct the line as shown on plan dated April 1931.

Moved by Cr. Rylett, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That the recommendation of the Engineer be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

The Minister of Public Works - Ottawa - wrote acknowledging receipt of night lettergrams re proposed bridgeover the Fraser River at or near Deas Island and advised that representations contained therein will be given consideration when the application is dealt with.

Moved by Cr. Rylett, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That the letter be received and filed and a copy of same be transmitted to the Special Bridge committee of New Westminster"

Carried unanimously.

His Worship the Reeve tabled correspondence between himself and the Minister of Labour at Ottawa in connection with suggestions of the Burnaby Workers Protective Association.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That the action of his Worship the Reeve in this connection be endorsed."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That copies of this correspondence be forwarded to the Provincial Government."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Rylett: "That this Council do now resolve into a committee of the whole with the Reeve in the chair to reconsider Burnaby Local Improvement construction By-law No. 7. 1931."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the committee do now rise and report the by-law complete without amendment."
Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.
Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That Burnaby Local Improvement Construction By-law No.7.1931 be now read a Third time."
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That Burnaby Local Improvement Construction By-law No.7.1931 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the Engineer be authorised to proceed with construction of sewer as provided for in Local Improvement Construction By-law No.7.1931."
Carried unanimously.

The Chairman - Transportation Committee submitted report on matter of extension of Car line on North Road, and recommended that the Engineer be instructed to communicate with the Engineers of the B.C.E.R.Coy., and ascertain what type of "high level" bridge would be satisfactory to all parties.

Moved by Cr.Rylett, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the report be received and the Engineer be instructed accordingly."
Carried unanimously.


Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr. Wilson: "That in connection with the work of the Greater Vancouver Water Board construction work in this Municipality the Engineer be instructed to see that proper crossings to private property are maintained, that local traffic be permitted on cross streets, and that through traffic be provided for each alternate street, with proper signs for the direction of the travelling public, and further that every effort be made to minimise damage to private property, and further that should any damage occur that same be made good forthwith."

Carried unanimously.

The Council then adjourned.
