An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, February 16th. 1931 at 7.30 p.m.

Mr. A. W. Macleod - Alderman Fenton and Mr. Robson representing the New Westminster Board of Trade and the City of New Westminster Council attended and addressed the meeting re proposal to build bridge over the Fraser River at Deas Island

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Rylett: "That this Council emphatically protest to the Department of Marine and to the Department of Public Works against the construction of any Bridge across the Fraser River below New Westminster which will be or may become a hindrance or menace to navigation."
