Monday June 22nd.1931.

An adjourned meeting of the Council, was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, June 22nd.1931 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.

Councillors Martin, Rylett, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Wilson.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. Geo. A. Grant, Commissioner, Capitol Hill re-plotting - requesting that services of official stenographer be supplied him for the hearing on June 23rd. Moved by Cr.Rylett, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That Mr.D.F.Saunders be engaged as official reporter for this hearing." Carried unanimously.

Secretary to Prime Minister - acknowledging receipt of resolution passed June 8th inst. re unemployment. Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the letter be received and filed." Carried unanimously.

Chairman Committee of the Executive Council on Unemployment Relief - acknowledging receipt of letter re Unemployment. Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the letter be received and filed." Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That this Council do now resolve into a committee of the whole with the Reeve in the chair to reconsider Local Improvement construction By-law No.12.1931." Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the committee do now rise and report the by-law complete without amendment." Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That Local Improvement Construction By-law No.12.1931 be now read a Third time." Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That Local Improvement Construction By-law No.12.1931 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto." Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the Engineer be authorised to proceed with construction of sidewalk as provided for in Local Improvement Construction By-law No.12.1931." Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That the Greater Vancouver Water District Easement Authorization By-law 1931 be introduced and read a first time." Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the Greater Vancouver Water District Easement Authorization By-law 1931 do pass the first reading." Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the Greater Vancouver Water District Easement Authorization By-law 1931 be now read a second time." Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the Greater Vancouver Water District Easement Authorization By-law 1931 do pass the second reading." Carried unanimously.

3. The Engineer submitted report and estimate under Section 30 of the Local Improvement Act on construction of sanitary sewer on Keefer Street between Madison Avenue and Rosser Avenue - Total estimated cost \$2,300.00 Estimated annual rate per foot front 23.58 cents.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Rylett: "That the report and estimate be received and filed." Carried unanimously.

4. His Worship the Reeve submitted report of Unemployment conference held at Victoria on June 15th inst.

Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That the report be received." Carried unanimously.

His Worship the Reeve submitted letter received by him from the Chief Engineer, Department of Public Works in which the Engineer requested information as to how much work had been made available to industry by reason of the works carried out in this Municipality under the Unemployment Relief monies His Worship advised that he had replied stating that as all the Unemployment relief monies had been expended on wages industry had not benefitted directly. Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That the letter and reply thereto be received and filed." Carried unanimously.

The Unemployment relief committee submitted following requests from the Burnaby Workers Protective Association, viz:

- (a) That they be supplied with sanitary cups.
 (b) That the Council as a body meet the executive on Wednesday evening.
 Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Martin: "That both requests be acceded to."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Wilson: "That the Council meet as a Committee of the whole on Wednesday evening to discuss matter of Municipal trucking."

Carried unanimously.

Councillor Wilson gave notice of motion as follows:

"That the Engineer be requested to submit recommendations for reorganization of his Department, with a view to efficiency and possible reduction of costs."

Moved by Cr.Rylett, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That this Council do now adjourn."

Carried unanimously.
