A Regular meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, July 27th, 1931 at 7:45 P.M.
Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.

Councillor Wheatley absent through illness.

Negativated - Crs. Rylett, Martin and Gray voting in favour.
His Worship the Reeve; Councillors Wilson & Lambert voting against.

The Engineer and Treasurer submitted a recommendation:- "That J. G. Ettinger and Wm. McCurragh be retired on Superannuation as at August 31st. and that a Committee be appointed to consider the question of retiring other employees who have reached the age of 60 years.

AND WHEREAS an error exists in the description of the location of these works in that "Harwood Street, Royal Oak Avenue Westerly 200" should be "Harwood Street, Royal Oak Avenue Easterly 200 ft." and "Regent Street, Westminster Avenue westerly 500 ft." should be "Regent Street, Westminster Avenue Easterly 500 ft."

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that these errors should be corrected.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. That the Schedule to the Burnaby Wards Road Loan By-law 1930, being By-law No. 1209, of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, be amended by striking out the following items, viz:

(a) Harwood Street, Royal Oak Avenue westerly 200 ft. Clearing full width, grading 26 feet, gravelling 1 4 ft. wide 4 in. deep and incidental works.

(b) Regent Street, Westminster Avenue westerly 500 ft. Gravelling 14 ft. wide, 4 in. thick, and incidental works and substituting therefor the following, viz:

(a) Harwood Street, Royal Oak Avenue easterly 200 ft. clearing full width, grading 26 feet, gravelling 14 ft. wide, 4 in. deep and incidental works.

(b) Regent Street, Westminster Avenue easterly 500 ft. Gravelling 14 ft. wide, 4 in. thick, and incidental works.

2. This By-law shall take upon receiving the approval of the Lieutenant Governor-in-Council.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Wards Road Loan By-law 1930, Amendment By-law 1931."
