

Monday - June 13th, 1932.

A Regular meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, June 13th, 1932 at 7.50 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.

Councillors Martin, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Hatherly.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Martin: "That the minutes of the meetings of May 30th ultimo and June 6th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."
Carried - Cr. Gray against.

Moved by Cr. Martin, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That Cr. Brown be granted leave of absence."
Carried unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. Burnaby Lake Ward 7 Ratepayers Assn - requesting that the Council exercise some supervision over bathers at Deer Lake to check the acts of vandalism now taking place.

Moved by Cr. Hatherly, Seconded by Cr. Gray: "That the letter be received and the matter be referred to the Board of Police Commissioners."
Carried unanimously.

2. N.E. Burnaby Ward 3 Ratepayers Association - suggesting that the following resolution be submitted to the Union of B.C. Municipalities convention:

"That in Municipalities such as Burnaby where a city rate of taxation prevails and where also "small ranches" are in operations that "the barns, chicken houses and other such buildings necessary for operation and which are really tools of production, should not be assessed for taxation purposes."

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Hatherly: "That the resolution be endorsed."
An amendment was

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Martin: "That this matter be referred to Finance Committee for consideration and recommendation."
The amendment carried - Cr. Lambert voting against.

3. Broadview Ratepayers Association - forwarding copy of petition forwarded to the B.C.E.R. requesting extension of Grandview Bus Service and requesting that same be endorsed by the Council.

Moved by Cr. Hatherly, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That the petition be endorsed by this Council and that the Chairman of Transportation and the Clerk be a committee to further the application in every way possible."
Carried unanimously.

W.R. Rutledge - M.L.A. - forwarding letter received by him from O. Naud complaining of the amount of taxation on Block 16, D.L. 82, and also as to lack of access, etc.

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Wheatley: "That the letter be received and the matter be referred to the Standing committee on Finance for report to the next meeting of the Committee."
An amendment was

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Hatherly: "That the letter be received and that Mr. Rutledge be advised that the matter can only be dealt with by the Court of Revision and that nothing can be done in the matter at this time."
The amendment was declared Lost - Reeve Pritchard and Councillors

Martin, Gray and Wheatley voting against.
The motion was then put and carried Crs. Lambert and Hatherly voting

against.
4. Chief Engineer - Department of Public Works - advising that the Provincial Government were limited in their power to extend time for completion of works provided for in agreement No. 46. to those works which were of such a character that the stopping of same would cause loss by reason of their non-completion.
Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. Hatherly: "That the letter be received and be referred to the Engineer for report to the next meeting of the Board of Works."
Carried unanimously.

5. W.H. McQuarrie & Co - forwarding copy of letter from W.E. Waddington re his claim to effect that Mr. Waddington was prepared to accept receipt for 1932 taxes plus balance of \$130.00 claim in full settlement.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Lench: "That this matter be referred to the Engineer to take up with the Corporation solicitor."
Carried unanimously.

6. Secretary, Union of B.C. Municipalities - advising that the 1932 Convention will be held at Nelson commencing June 25th, and that Good Roads league will convene June 26th.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Martin: "That the letter be received and filed."
Carried unanimously.

7. Assistant Fire Marshal - Vancouver - advising that the Department has no objection to the construction of frame public garage in the 4100 block Hastings St.

Moved by Cr. Wheatley, Seconded by Cr. Lench: "That the letter be received and that the provisions of the Burnaby Building By-law be waived to permit of the construction of a frame garage in the 4100 block Hastings Street."
Carried unanimously.

A.W.Allard and others - requesting that an outlet at North end of Wellington Avenue and the B.C.E.R. Right of way be provided for convenience of residents of Wellington Avenue.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That the petition be received and that the matter be referred to the Clerk, Engineer, the Councillor for the Ward and the Chairman of Transportation for consideration and recommendation."

Carried unanimously.

Broadview Ratepayers Association - advising that the Association were opposed to the proposal to establish an Interment Park in Burnaby. Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That the letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

James G.West - requesting that balance of back pay due him for work as foremen at MacPherson Park be applied to his 1932 taxes. Moved by Cr.Bray, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That this matter be referred to the Clerk, His Worship the Reeve, Councillor Wheatley and the Treasurer for report to Committee on Monday next."

Carried unanimously.

J.G.West - requesting information with reference to policy of the Council in matter of arrears of water rates incurred by tenant. Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That the letter be received and be referred to standing committee on finance together with the Chairman of Water Committee and the Engineer."

Carried unanimously.

Burnaby Workers Council - requesting the following:

- (a) That the order issued by the Relief department relative to cutting of wood for fuel be abolished forthwith.
- (b) That transportation be furnished recipients of direct relief who have to travel very long distances in order to have their script filled.
- (c) That the rectangular partition extending to the centre of the public Hall, now housing the staff of the relief department be removed and that a temporary collapsible or removable barrier be installed in order that the said hall be again made available for public meetings, and that the work now carried on behind the white screen be carried on in the anti-rooms in the west side of the building.
- (d) That inexpensive measures be put into effect to overcome temporarily at least - the very bad acoustic properties of the present Council Chamber immediately.
- (e) That at any time Municipal delegations are sent to interview the government at Victoria, or any of its especially designated representatives, a delegation of like number be requested to accompany them from the Burnaby Workers Council - this arrangement to obtain only when said government or its representatives are to be interviewed on matters pertaining to unemployment or direct relief; and that the Municipal Council arrange that the Workers delegates speak at these interviews.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That the communication be received."

Carried - Cr.Lambert against.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That item "A" be referred to the Health, Relief, Telephones and Fire committee and that copy of the order referred to be supplied to each member of the Council."

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That item "C" be referred to the Hall and Grounds committee."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That in regard to item "E" this organization be advised that all delegations going from this Council are sent on Municipal business and that if any other organization wish to send delegation it is within their own powers."

Lost - Reeve Fritchard & Councillors Hatherly, Martin, and Lambert voting against.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That the communication be filed."

Carried unanimously.

John Davidson - Municipal Engineer - tendering his resignation to take effect immediately.

Shell Oil Company of B.C.Limited - requesting that a temporary 2" water supply be given them a distance of 600 feet up Kensington Avenue from Hastings St. the total cost to be paid by the Company and the pipe to become the property of the Company when permanent main is laid.
