

Monday - February 15 th, 1932.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, February 15th, 1932 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.

Councillors Martin, Brown, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Hatherly.

The Board of School Trustees wrote advising that owing to receipt of communication from the Minister of Education relative to grants towards Teachers salaries they found it impossible to favourably consider any reduction in the Ordinary Estimates of the Board for the current year and requested that the Council approve the Estimates as submitted. The Board further promised that should they be in a position after a conference with the Minister of Education to make any reduction same would be immediately made.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That the Ordinary Estimates of the Board of School Trustees amounting to \$242,663.45 be received."  
Carried - Cr.Martin against.

The Minister of Education wrote giving particulars of the grants proposed towards School Teachers salaries, and advising that Burnaby was rated as a Sub-class "E" Municipality and that grant would be on basis of 42%. The Minister further wrote advising that the grant would be based on amount of salary that was legally payable to the teacher in December 1930 or in December 1931 whichever was the smaller amount, and the grant to be based on the salary of a teacher appointed by a Board since December 1931, will be calculated on a salary which has been approved by the Supt. of Education.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Brown: "That the letter be received and that a copy of each letter be supplied to each Councillor."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Martin: "That the Estimate of Extra ordinary expenditure amounting to \$2,449.60 be approved."  
Carried unanimously.

Secretary, Burnaby Branch, V.O.N. wrote forwarding copy of annual statement and requested a grant similar to that of last year.

Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Gray: "That this application be referred to committee on estimates."  
Carried unanimously.

C.M.C. Richmond Municipality forwarded copy of resolution relative to having legislation brought down providing for declaration of nationality on all Conveyances and Agreements for sale, and requested endorsement of same at the convention of the Union of B.C.Municipalities.

Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Gray: "That the letter be received and be referred to delegates to convention."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That the resolution passed on February 8th inst. relative to leasing Canadian Legion Hall North Burnaby be and is hereby rescinded."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the Clerk be instructed to again ask the City of New Westminster for formal approval and permission to construct a car line on Columbia Street east from the terminus of the present line to the Brunette River."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Martin: "That this Council express its regret that the Provincial Government has seen fit to reduce the grant to the University of British Columbia to such an extent that many intending students may be debarred from attending the said University and further that the standard of the said University may be seriously reduced, and that the Provincial Government be earnestly requested to give further consideration to this matter, with a view to maintaining the said University at its present high standard."  
Carried - Cr. Lambert against.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Martin: "That the invitation of the Ward 1 Ratepayers association for the members of the Council to attend meeting on Tuesday, February 16th inst. be accepted."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Martin: "That this Council do now adjourn."

Carried unanimously.
