

Monday - October 24th.1932.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, October 24th.1932 at 7.30 p.m.  
Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard.  
Councillors Martin, Brown, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Hatherly.

1. Mrs.M.Scott, Secretary, Ancient Order of Foresters - Court East Burnaby submitted application for Dance Hall permit for Foresters Hall.  
Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That the permit be granted."  
Carried unanimously.
2. A.F.McGavin applied for Dance permit for Grays Hall for Saturday evenings.  
Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That this application be referred to the Chief Constable for report."  
Carried unanimously.

His Worship the Reeve submitted statement showing cheques received re Direct and Unemployment Relief up to and including October 24th inst.  
Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the report be received."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That the Treasurer bring down report showing expenditures under agreement No.46, together with amount received from the Dominion, and Provincial Governments and also amount received on loan, expenditures to be shown separately for period prior to close down in January, and amount expended since resumption of the work."  
Carried unanimously.

3. His Worship the Reeve submitted report on matter of Haywood and Buckley case advising that he had lifted the suspension on Buckley and had instructed the Relief officer to use his discretion in matter of further relief for Haywood.  
Moved by Cr.Wheatley, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That the report be received."  
Carried unanimously.

The Relief Officer submitted report for week October 10th to 15th. showing total amount of direct relief granted as \$9,047.47  
Moved by Cr.Hatherly, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the report be received."  
Carried - Crs.Martin and Brown voting against.

The Relief officer submitted report showing number of investigations carried out for week of October 17th to 22nd. as - 266.  
Moved by Cr.Wheatley, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That the report be received."  
Carried unanimously.

The Relief Officer submitted report as to general conditions of stores continuing to supply relief orders, showing 116 cases in South Burnaby, and 17 cases in North Burnaby, as receiving partial orders only.  
Moved by Cr.Wheatley, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That the report be received."

An amendment was  
Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Brown: "That the report be received and that matter of rotation of recipients receiving partial orders be referred to the standing Relief committee for consideration."

The amendment carried unanimously.  
Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That in future reports dealing with activities of the Relief department be submitted over the signatures of the Relief Officer, the Chairman Relief Committee and His Worship the Reeve."  
Lost - Crs.Gray, Lench and Brown voting in favour - Councillors Martin, Lambert, Wheatley, Hatherly and Reeve Pritchard voting against.

The Engineer submitted report showing expenditures made on works under agreement No.46. as revised.  
Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Martin: "That this report be referred to Board of Works."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That the Council meet as a Committee of the whole one evening this week to go into financial situation and as to what arrangements have been made with the Bank for future financing."  
Carried unanimously.

Wednesday October 26th.1932 at 8 p.m. set as date of meeting.

The Council then adjourned.
