

Thursday - April 28th.1932.

A meeting of the Council sitting as a committee of the whole was held at the Municipal Hall on Thursday, April 28th.1932 at 7.30 p.m.  
Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.  
Councillors Martin, Brown, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Hatherly.

The Relief officer submitted report on matter of rents.

Messrs G.Conway Brown; Mr.Campbell, and Dr.McIvor attended and addressed the committee matter of payment of rents of recipients of Direct relief.

It was agreed that landlords would co-operate with Council in representations on this matter to Provincial Government.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Brown: "That the Chairman Relief Committee, with the Treasurer and Relief officer be a committee to formulate the position of the Council in this matter, and to transmit same to the North and South Burnaby Boards of Trade, more particularly as to the financial side of the question."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That this Council go on record as to appreciating the necessity of providing shelter for Relief cases, and that the Municipal Clerk be requested to write Mr.Conway Brown as representing the owners of rented houses asking for co-operation by owners in presenting a case for the consideration of the Provincial Government."

Carried unanimously.

The matter of Park appropriations for the year 1932 was then discussed.

The Treasurer submitted recommendation that balance be left unappropriate at this time.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the matter be referred back to the Standing Parks Committee with the Treasurer and Engineer to submit recommendations to the Council."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the matter of providing employment for Direct relief cases be tabled for at least one week."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Wheatley, Seconded by Cr.Gray: "That all matters referred to the committee on estimates not yet dealt with be referred to the chairman of the respective standing committees."

Carried - Cr.Martin against.

The committee then adjourned.
