L.C.Mahhott - on behalf of the Local Council of Unemployed Councils of Burnaby advising that a delegation from a demonstration of workers will attend the Municipal Hall at 2 o'clockp.m. Friday, December 16th. 1932 and requesting that the Municipal Council be in attendance to hear their petition regarding (1) An ammesty for all political prisoners (2) certain local matters and (3) Non-contributory by workers Unemployment Insurance. Moved by Cr. Wheatley, Seconded by Cr. Hatherly: "That the letter be received and as many of the Council as can do so be present at the time and place requested. Carried unanimously.

Secretary, Civic Employees Union - requesting that every effort be made to have regular outside employees of the Corporation more regularly employed.
