

Wednesday, April 6th.1932.

A meeting of the Council sitting as a Committee of the Whole was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, April 6th.1932 at 8 o'clock p.m.

Present: His Worship the Reeve in the chair.

Councillors Martin, Brown, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Hatherly.

Messrs McDonald and Pettipiece of the Trades and Labour Council attended and requested permission to address the Committee re R.Stevens.

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr.Martin: "That the delegation be heard";

The delegation addressed the Committee requesting that Mr.R.Stevens, late Water superintendent be given some employment with Corporation.

No resolution.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Gray: "That item Town Planning Commission - Major road surveys \$550.00 be struck out."

Carried unanimously.

1. Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That item Town Planning Commission - Zoning By-law and advertising \$1200.00 - be struck out."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr. Brown "That item "Contingent - \$10,000.00 - pass."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That item - Municipal Government - Audit fees - \$800.00 - pass."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That Council indemnifies except Reeve's indemnify be reduced by 10%"

His Worship the Reeve vacated the chair.

The Acting Reeve - Cr.Lambert declined to take the chair.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That Cr.Gray do take the chair."

Carried unanimously.

The motion was then put and declared Lost - Crs. Martin, Lambert and Gray voting in favour - Crs. Lench, Brown, Wheatley and Hatherly voting against.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That Cr.Gray do now vacate the chair

Carried unanimously.

His Worship the Reeve resumed the chair.

Moved by Cr.Lench, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That item - Council Indemnities - \$5,500.00 - pass."

Carried - Crs. Martin, Lambert and Gray against.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That item - Election expenses - \$2,000.00 - pass."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Wheatley, Seconded by Cr.Hatherly: "That matter of 5 day week be re-considered."

Negatived - Crs. Lambert, Wheatley and Hatherly and Reeve Pritchard voting in favour - Crs. Martin, Brown, Lench and Gray voting against.

2. Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lench: "That salary of Engineer Mr.Davidson be reduced to \$3,600.00; that salaries of Mr.Southwell, Mr.Hawkins, and Mr. Scott be reduced by 10%; that salary of Mr.Etches be reduced by 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ %, and Messrs Davidson and Scott alternate, and that Messrs Hawkins and Southwell alternate until conditions otherwise warrant."

Carried - Crs. Hatherly and Reeve Pritchard voting against.

Moved by Cr.Martin, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That following reductions in salaries Clerks Department and General office be made, i.e.

Salaries of from \$1000. to \$1500.00	5%
1500. to 2000.00	7 $\frac{1}{2}$ %
" over \$2000.00	10%

3 and that no change be made in salaries under \$1000.00, and that this be basis for all other departments, except the Engineering Department, over which the Council has jurisdiction."

Carried - Reeve Pritchard and Cr.Hatherly against.

The Committee then adjourned.
