An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Saturday, January 9th. 1932 at 11.00 a.m.

Present: His Worship the Reeve in the chair.

Councillors Martin, Rylett, Lambert, Lench, Wheatley, Gray and Wilson.

The Engineer submitted programme of unemployment relief works amounting to \$400,000.00 - \$273,900.00 for Labour and \$126,100.00 for Material etc Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Wilson: "That the programme be amended by substituting the words "Storm water drainage" for the words "Storm sewers" in Ward 1, and the words "Storm water drainage" for the Words "Storm sewers" in Ward 6, and that the programme of works as so amended be forwarded to the Provincial Government with a letter setting forth the present conditions of unemployment relief works."

His Worship the Reave read telegrams forwarded to Mr.M.H.McGeomgh and replies thereto as follows:

Jan. 2nd. Provincial Government paid own and Burnaby's proportion of vouchers accounts totalling \$67,383.39. Dominion proportion not to hand. Essential on account financial (position that Dominion proportion \$67,383.39 be paid Immediately. W.A.Pritchard Reeve.

Jan 7th. No reply my wire 2nd January. Have expended to date \$219.336.00 Bank advises will extend no further credit until substantial payments are made reducing present ouligations. Municipality's credit must be maintained Please have requisits steps taken for Dominion share to be paid. W.A.Pritchard Reeve Burnaby

Jan 8th. Your telegram received. Domini n government does not send funds direct to Municipality and you must therefore make application to Province with whom your agreement is. Understand Dominion Government has made substantial payments to Province on account unemployment relief although Burnaby account not yet received at Ottawa M.H.McGeough.

Moved by Cr.Wilson, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That this meeting do now adjourn." Carried unanimously.
