

Wednesday - November 1st. 1933.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, November 1st. 1933 at 10.30 p.m.

Present: Commissioner John Mahony and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sittings of October 25th and October 30th ultimos be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Ocean View Burial Park Coy. - advising that in future the Company found it necessary to make the following charges in connection with the opening and closing of graves supplied for indigents:

\$5.00 for a Baby up to 2 years of age.  
\$7.00 for a Child 2 to 10 years of age.  
\$10.00 for all over 10 years of age, including adults.
