

Wednesday - October 4th, 1933.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, October 4th, 1933 at 10.00 a.m.  
Present: Commissioner John Bennett and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of September 27th ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Timber Preservers Ltd., - requesting that the agreement respecting supply of water to their premises at a monthly minimum fee of \$50.00 be suspended until such time as business conditions improve, agreeing in the meantime to pay for the water actually consumed at the regular rate.  
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and that the agreement be suspended for a period of three months commencing October 1st, 1933."

The Acting Deputy Municipal Engineer's report recommending that the water main on Scott Street and Alberta Street be replaced with a 3" Wood stave pipe at an estimated cost of \$850.00 was considered.  
Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Engineer be and is hereby adopted."
