

Wednesday April 5th.1933.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, April 5th.1933 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Bennett and Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of March 29th ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. G.M.Trainor - requesting permission to use Lot 62A SD 1/2, Block 3, D.L.74.8¹ for garden purposes.
Ordered: "That the use of the above lot be granted to Mr.Trainor for the balance of the year at a nominal rental of \$1.00"
2. A.Christofferson - requesting permission to use Lot 8, Block 14, D.L.29. for garden purposes.
Ordered: "That the use of the above lot be granted to Mr.Christofferson for the balance of the year at a nominal rental of \$1.00"
3. G.H.Moore - tendering his resignation as Clerk in the General Office to become effective on May 1st.1933.
Ordered: "That the resignation be accepted."
4. The Treasurer submitted a recommendation that an allowance under Section 274 of the Municipal Act be made to Mr.Thos.Fobertson on Lot 10, Block 9, D.L..151-3 amounting to \$12.33 being percentage addition on 1932 taxes.
Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Treasurer be adopted."

The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted Estimates of work for approval as follows:

5. The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted a recommendation that Mr.J.W. Cunningham be granted an extension of time to June 30th next for removal of wood from Blocks 31 to 35, inc. D.L. 11.
Ordered: "That this recommendation be tabled pending inspection on the ground."
6. The Deputy Municipal engineer submitted report advising that a tree situated on Lot 2, Block A D.L. 8. was dangerous to the public safety and recommended that the owner Mr.A.Kingsnorth be ordered to have same topped immediately above the uppermost live branch by within 14 days from date of notice.
ordered: "That the recommendation be adopted."

7. The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted a report advising that an error had been made in compiling the assessment under Local Improvement By-law No. 593. in that parcel described as N.E. part Blk.39. D.L. 151-3 had been charged with frontage of 330 feet, whereas the lot was entitled to reduction under Subsection 1 of Section 24 of the Local Improvement Act leaving an assessable frontage of 206.25 feet. Herecommended that action be taken under subsection 4 of Section 47 to remedy same.
Ordered: "That the report be tabled for further consideration."

The Engineer and Treasurersubmitted report on application of Mr. Harry V Hives for water service to his property on Bennett Street and submitted an estimate of cost of installing a 2" main on Bennett Street from Nelson Avenue 290 feet east. amounting to \$138.50. The Committee recommended that Mr. Hives be permitted to supply all labour in trenching andback filling and to receive a credit of \$40.60 as water rates paid in advance.
Ordered: "That the estimate be adopted and that the recommendation be adopted."

The Requisitions were then examined.

Ordered: "That the requisitions as submitted be approved."
